KClimb Mont Blanc

The highest peak in the Alps at 4,810 meters, Mont Blanc extends its arms to everyone who love the mountains. Skiing, hiking or even photography enthusiasts will all find something to satisfy their passion by exploring its slopes or trails.

Admire the Mer de Glace glacier

Covering forty square kilometers and seven kilometers wide, the Mer de Glace is the largest glacier in France. Monumental, it is one of the most visited natural sites in the world.

To get there, board the famous little red cogwheel train. The train's mountainside route climbs trough tunnels cut in the rock and some viaducts. On arrival, a breathtaking panorama awaits you: below you look out over the glacier, a true witness to the climate changes of our time!

Santa Thrill in the Aiguille du Midi cable car

Culminating at 3,777 meters, the Aiguille du Midi cable car is the highest in Chamonix, offering a unique and dizzying panorama: Mont Blanc, glaciers and seracs are at your feet.

Here you can experience the "Pas dans le Vide": enter a 2x2m glass cage and find yourself immersed in nature over a 1000m drop under your feet, the feeling of diving into the valley!

Snowshoe hike

Discover breathtaking snow-covered landscapes in a novel way. Discover the winter flora and fauna and maybe you will have the opportunity to see animal tracks!

KRunning a trail

With the Mont Blanc marathon, the UTMB® or the Aiguilles Rouges trail, Chamonix is the favored meeting place for runners, providing superb cross-country trails in summer in a majestic setting.
