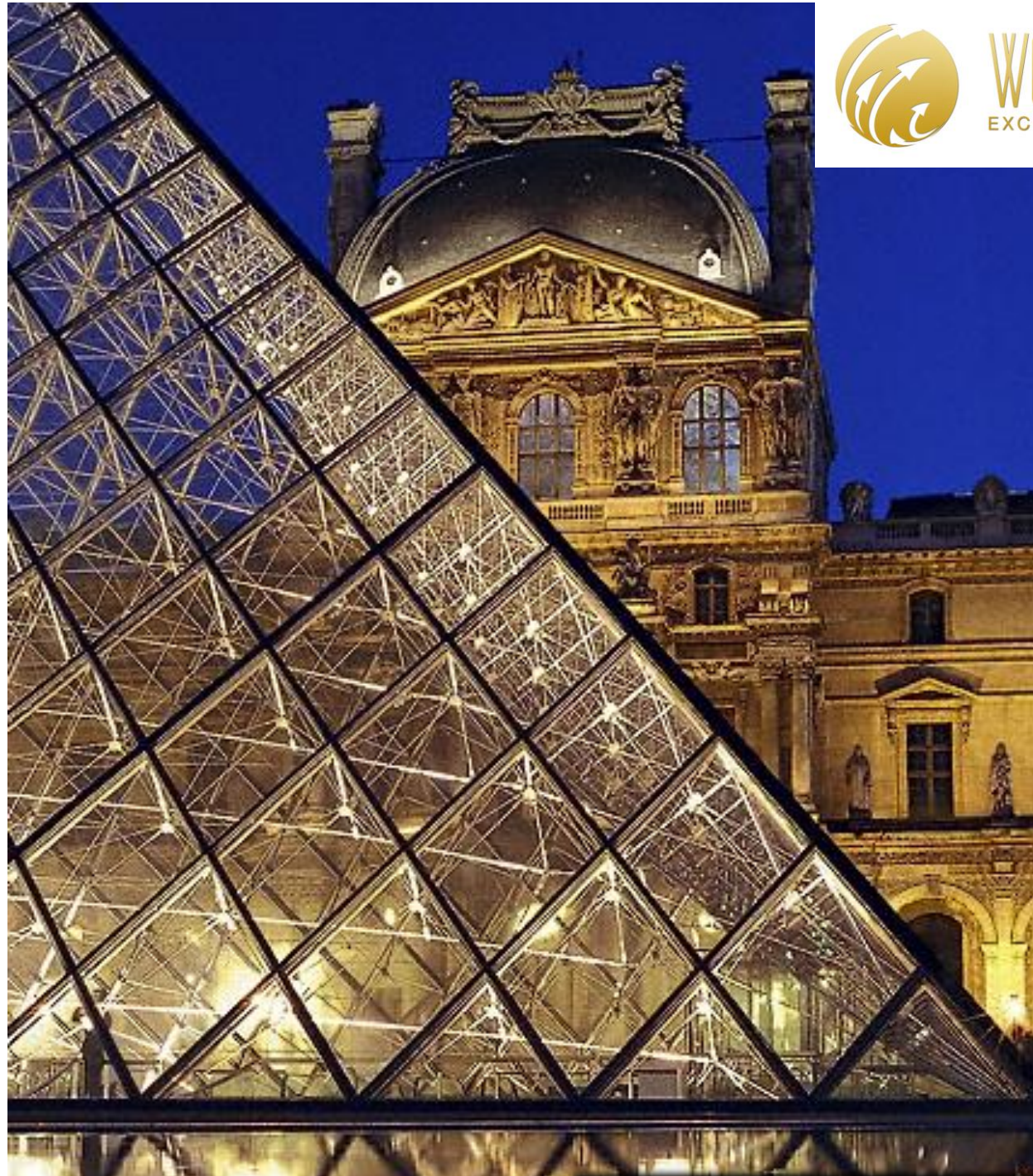
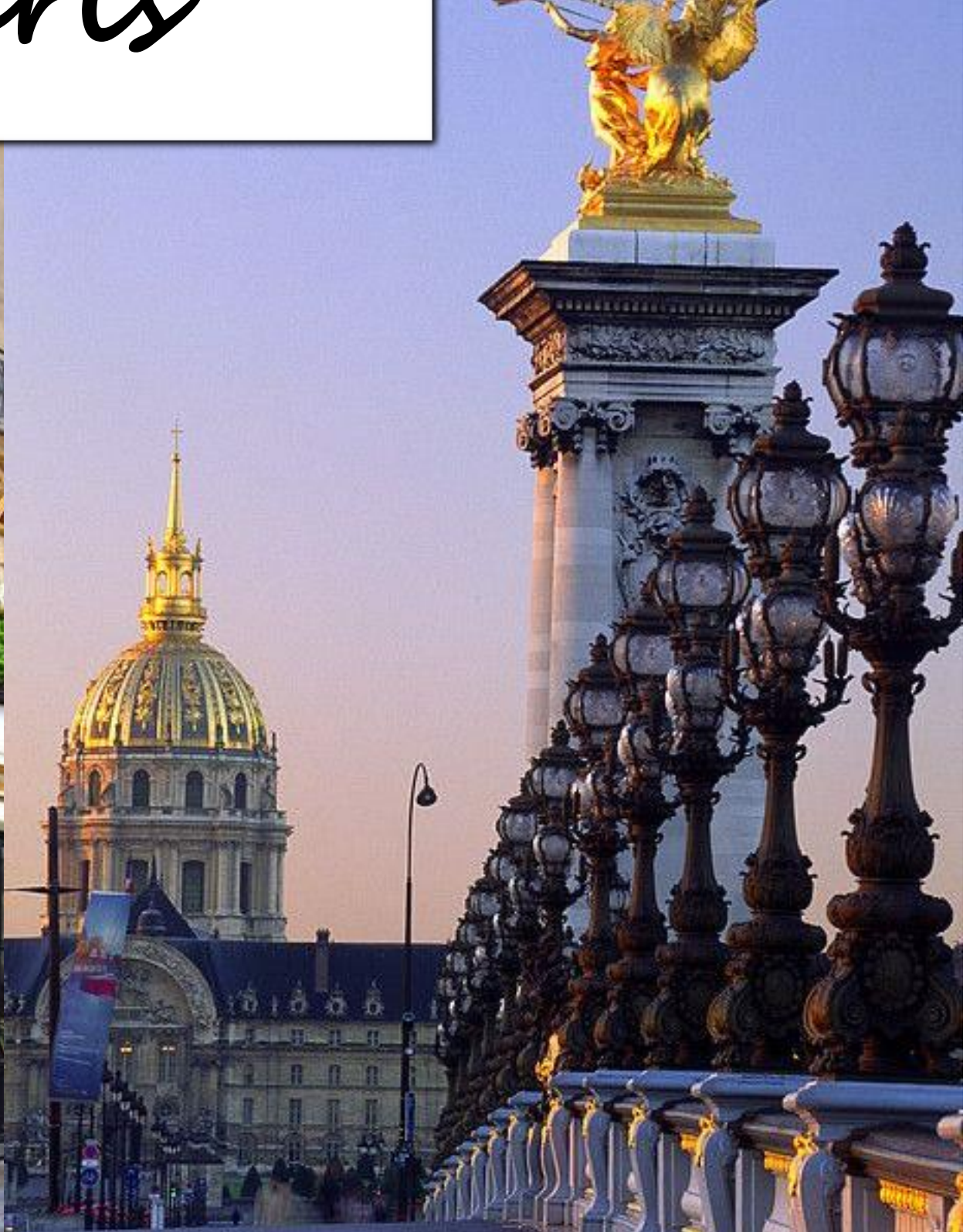

### ☀️ **Paris National Opera - Palais Garnier**

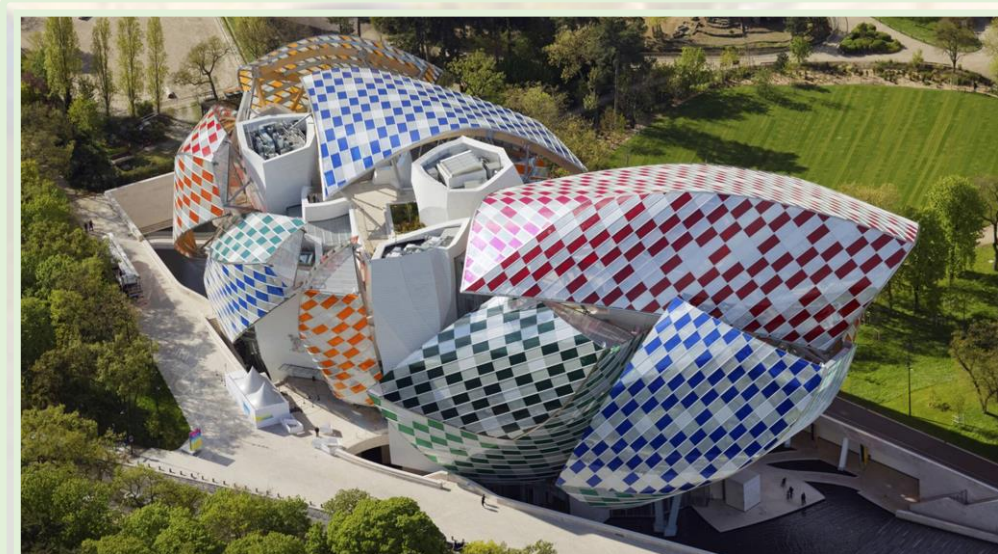
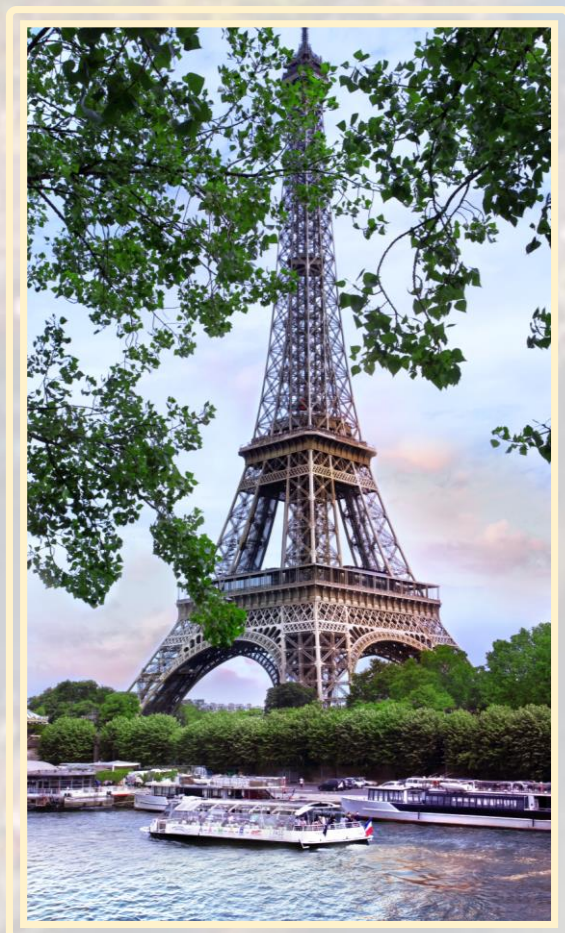
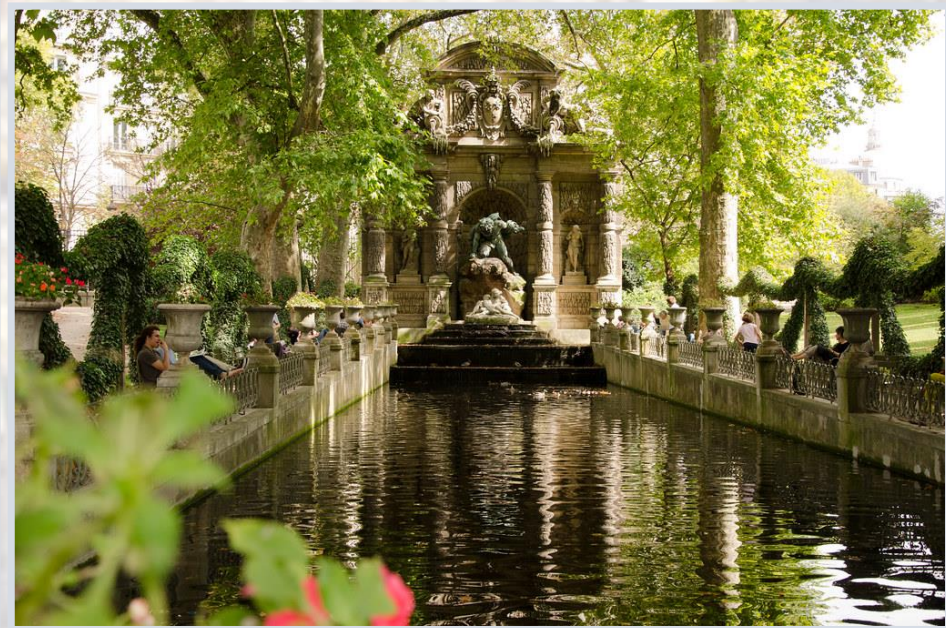
